Road Closures – Halloween Parade/Celebration and Halloween Night

Pursuant to Chapter 216 of the Wallingford Town Code, the following road closures and parking prohibitions will be in effect for all vehicular:

Halloween Parade/Celebration – Friday, October 28th

South Main Street, between the intersection of Center Street and Prince Street will be closed to all motor vehicle traffic on **Friday, October 28, 2022 starting at 3:00 pm** for a Halloween Event being hosted by the Town of Wallingford Public Celebrations Committee and Parks and Recreation Department. The closure is expected to last until approximately 9:00 pm.

There will be **no parking on South Main Street** between Center Street and Prince Street on Friday, October 28, 2022 starting at 2:30 pm. Please be reminded that vehicles parked in violation of this prohibition will be subject to the issuance of a parking ticket by police and removal by tow truck.

Halloween Night – Monday, October 31st

North Main Street between the intersection of North Street and Cedar Lane will be closed to all motor vehicle traffic on **Monday, October 31, 2022 starting at 4:30 pm** for the safety of the large volume of pedestrians anticipated on Halloween night. The closure is expected to last until approximately 9:00 pm.

There will be **no parking on North Main Street** between North Street and Cedar Lane on Monday, October 31, 2022 starting at 4:00 pm. Please be reminded that vehicles parked in violation of this prohibition will be subject to the issuance of a parking ticket by police and removal by tow truck.
