

Man Arrested After Foot Chase through Grocery Store

On March 17, 2023, Wallingford Police responded to M&T Bank within Stop & Shop at 930 North Colony Road for a fraud in progress involving a male suspect. The suspect possessed a fake license in the name of a true M&T account holder. He was attempting to withdraw several thousand dollars from that customer's account when police arrived. When officers began to question the suspect, he fled leading officers on a foot pursuit through the grocery store, out the front entrance, to the side of the building in the parking lot where officers were ultimately able to apprehend him.

The male was identified as 43-year-old Scott Morrissey of LKA 1141 FDR Drive #4C, NY, NY. Morrissey was charged with violation of Connecticut General Statutes 53a-129c- Identity Theft 2nd Degree, 53a-49/53a-124- Criminal Attempt at Larceny 3rd Degree, 53a-167a- Interfering with an Officer, and 53a-130- Criminal Impersonation. He was held on a \$5,000.00 bond and issued a court date of April 19, 2023 at 9:00AM.
