**Jubilee Parade, Saturday, June 18<sup>th</sup>**

The Jubilee Parade will start at approximately 1:30 pm from Moses Y. Beach Elementary School on North Main Street and conclude at Lyman Hall High School on Pond Hill Road. All affected roadways have been posted.
