## **Shots Fired/ Catalytic Converter Theft in Wallingford**

On March 27, 2022 at 0237 hours, the Wallingford Police Department responded to 69 South Turnpike Road for a shots fired incident where the victim interrupted the theft of catalytic converters. The theft was committed by three Hispanic males, who were wearing ski type masks and dark clothing. After the victim interrupted them, one of the suspects chambered and fired a round from an unknown type of handgun. No injuries were reported.

The males fled the scene in the pictured brown 2011 or newer Honda Accord bearing a possible Massachusetts registration. This case was transferred to the Wallingford Police Detective Division.

The Wallingford Police Department would like to remind citizens to call the police as soon as possible after a crime has occurred, or prior to the crime occurring if at all possible. It's always best to let police handle a dangerous situation however, always use extreme caution when making a decision to confront someone committing a crime.
