On Saturday April 30, 2022 from 9AM-12PM, the Wallingford Police Department will be hosting the Wallingford Lion's Club Fundraiser Shred Event & Food Drive at our headquarters, 135 North Main Street, Wallingford, CT 06492. This event provides area residents and businesses an opportunity to shred important documents for a very reasonable cost, and in a very safe environment. The cost to shred will be \$10 per banker's box of documents and \$20 for tall kitchen bags of documents. Persons wishing to take advantage of the service can pull up, remain in their car as the Lions and their assistants take your shred items to the truck. You will be able to see them destroyed in front of you. The Lion's club asks that you bring a non-perishable food item when you visit!

All donations will benefit Master's Mana. We hope you will consider utilizing this great service and at the same time helping the Lions to better serve our community.

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Drug Take Back Event Details

Also on Saturday April 30, 2022 from 10AM-2PM, in partnership with Coalition for a Better Wallingford, the Wallingford Police Department is hosting a drug take back event. The event is part of the Federal Drug Agency's National Prescription Drug Take Back Day. The event will be located at the police department, 135 North Main Street. The event is designed to make police officers and members of the Coalition more available to the community and keep prescription drugs off of the street.

The event is anonymous and there will be no questions asked of anyone turning in prescription drugs. Participants can drive through the police parking lot, hand the prescriptions to an officer, and drive out. There will be a DEA agent on hand and all items will be taken off site to be disposed of.
