Wallingford Police Announce New Community Impact Unit

The Wallingford Police Department is excited to announce a new unit designed and staffed to deal with specific issues community wide. The Community Impact Unit will deliver high-level problem resolution to a wide variety of community related issues that need immediate and direct impact to resolve the issue. While some issues may linger for some time after initial response, the Community Impact Unit will ensure that the issue is resolved to the satisfaction of both the affected community member and the police department. This high-energy unit will work in both uniform and plain-clothes to accomplish the tasks that the individual issue presents. The scope of this unit shall ultimately free up time that the uniformed patrol division has to spend on these matters, thereby allowing the patrol officer to tend to other duties within their patrol zone that require their attention. Officers assigned to this unit shall expect to work varying hours and interact with other town departments that can assist with problem resolution. Staffing of the unit is expected to occur in the near future.

The following are examples of the potential work associated with this unit:

- Walk and Talk with Businesses, Clergy, Residents
- Blight
- Unregistered cars on public and private property
- Continuing noise complaints
- Narcotics
- Quality of Life issues
- Parking enforcement
- Thefts from vehicles
